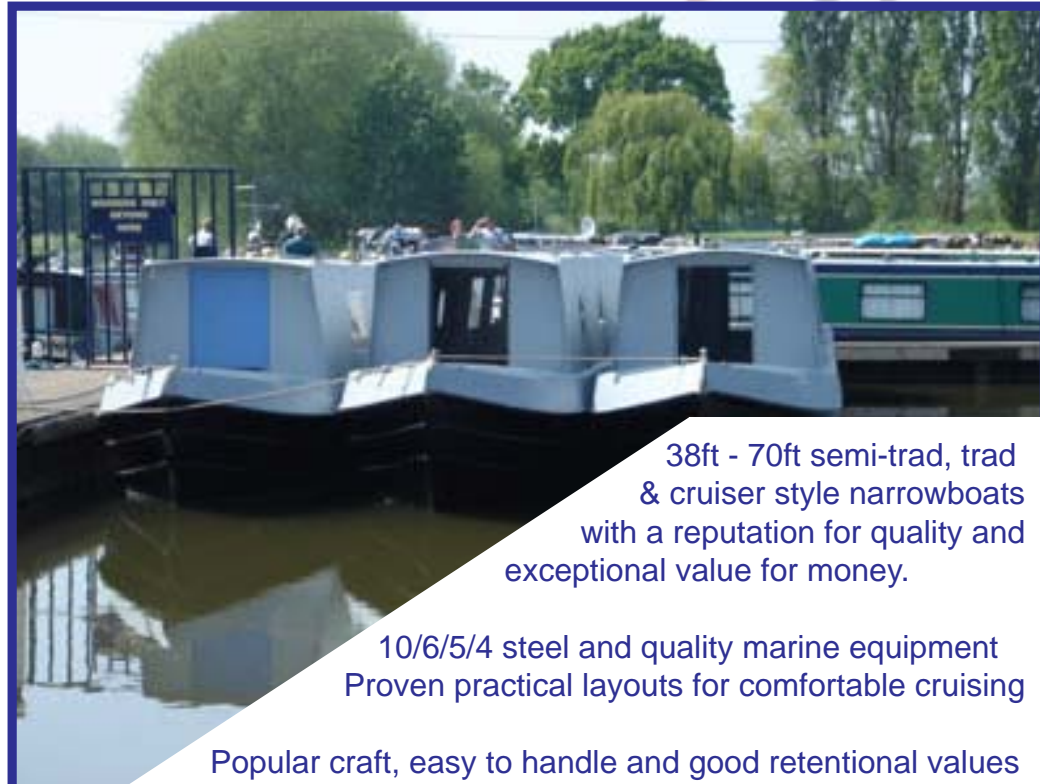

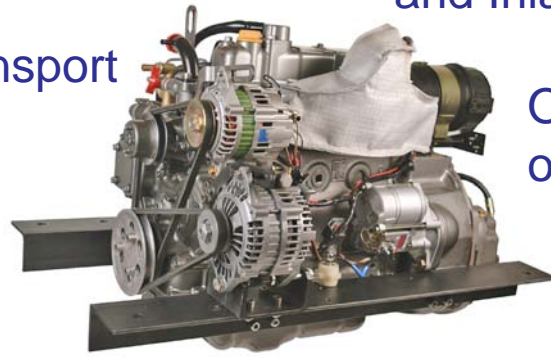

Sailaways

- 10mm baseplate, 6mm hull side, 5mm cabin, 4mm cabin roof.
- Quick release weedhatch, centreroof ring & pole rack
- Cast forward Tee stud, stern dollies & side fender eyes.
- Gas locker with bottle securing rings.
- Diesel tank with engine feed and return pipes.
- Steel stern doors & sliding hatch.
- Engine installed and commissioned.
- Cabin roof vents fitted.
- Hardwood front doors
with glazed upper section.
- Ballast & floor

- PU spray foam
- Fixings for bulkheads
- Veneered panels on cabin sides and hull.
- Hardwood cappings on cabin roof and hull and lower cabin panel sides.
- Windows trims to suit lining.
- 1st fix of 12V electric circuits.
- 1st fix of 240V ring main
- 1st fix plumbing for H&C supplies to galley & shower cabin.
